Summer Highlights (2013)

We played in a Drop-in Center (for over 500 displaced flood victims & homeless) & also helped clean out a flooded basement in a devastated river section of downtown Calgary.

After the Trans-Canada opened, we resumed our plans, ministering in a Presbyterian Church (through our good friends & hosts, Will & Michelle). The Pastor invited us to do a Saturday evening Watch-Concert and Sunday morning offertory. This was a sweet time of worship and reunion with some of our dearest friends (Lorraine & Tisch) from our early days of marriage. A tourist town is not an easy place to minister and the Watch (Harp & Bowl) Concert was a real encouragement to Pastor Clay who said it was like water for a dry well. Cathy, his wife, invited us to share a special meal with their family.
