Parallel Universes

In quantum mechanics, the definition of a parallel universe is theorized as existing alongside our own universe *although undetectable*. In the world of fiction, a parallel universe is conceived of as *coexisting with* and having certain similarities to the known world but different from it in some fundamental way).

Jesus said, [Don't look here or there externally] "...for behold, the Kingdom of God is within you." (Paraphrased, Luke 17:21) Jesus also said, I will open my mouth in parables [riddles]. I will utter things hidden since the foundation of the world." (Matt 13:35)

Recently, I saw a shadow of a tree (with a strong wind blowing through the branches & leaves). It created a movie-like image, as though dancing, on my living room wall. Instantly I knew God was wanting to show me something—that dancing shadow caught my attention as though it was real, but in reality it was just a shadow. Hmm, I thought, this is like our current earthly existence—just a shadow of the real universe. That shadow momentarily *distracted* me from looking at the "real world" (a real tree and a real sun etc). How often are we distracted by worldly things?

In that moment, I realized God was inviting me into a deeper understanding of His parallel universe—a reality that is far more "real" than anything we've known or seen in this physical world. An invitation pointing to an invisible, yet deeper, coexisting universe: the Kingdom of God!

Pilot asked Jesus if He was a king. Jesus answered, "My Kingdom is not of this world..." (John 18:36). Hebrews states we have "come into" this parallel universe—the heavenly Zion! (Heb 12:22)

If we are "born again," we have been delivered out of this present world of "shadows" into the real universe of His unshakable Kingdom that will never pass away. In Hebrews 11, we're shown that the *currency* of this kingdom is faith! In John 4:21-24, we're told the *vehicle* by which we go there is worshiping Him in Spirit and Truth!

In humility, through our "born again" spirit, we can worship: training our spiritual senses—to see, hear, smell, taste & feel what is really real.

Let's go "parallel" daily—its our privilege and inheritance!
