# **Thoughts from the Prayer Room**

Divine Order & Restoring the Tabernacle of David—what does that mean in our modern (New Testament) lives? It represents God's people in transition. When God initiated the Tabernacle or Tent of David, it was a time of movement and transition into "something new" during a time of instability. Jeremiah 7:1-16 instructs the people of God to "go back to Shiloh (which means Messiah or "Peaceful One", He who is to be Sent & Place of Rest). Why? Because the story of Shiloh is a story of transition into a Samuel Generation: Eli, the priest of Shiloh, failed to discipline his sons—ultimately causing the established place of worship to be abandoned. David was also doing the right thing in the wrong way (God permitted the oxen to stumble—revealing Uzzah's irreverence).

Summary: God is raising a set (consecrated) generation that is Blood cleansed, Water (Word) Washed and Holy Spirit Anointed! These transitional "set" ones will 1. Prepare a Place, 2. Gather His sheep and 3. Put Things into Divine Order. (Establishing a place and time of Encounter vs Doing what is Right in Our Own Eyes). Fear of the Lord, come!
