Thoughts From the Upper Room

Jesus modeled a life of prayer in such a way that His disciples wanted to live the same. His life provoked them to ask, “Jesus, how do you pray? Jesus answered, “Pray in *this way*—Our Father, *in heaven*, hallowed be Thy name. Thy kingdom come, Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven...” (Matt 6:6+). Jesus modeled confidence in approaching the Father, beginning with worship, *accessing heaven!* Prayer = heavenly perspective (we can find Him and His will in heaven!). He then took 3 of them to pray on the Mountain of Transfiguration—modeling how to dialogue in prayer in heaven, while on earth!! (Luke 9:28). There’s a curious verse in Acts 1:21. The disciples were looking to replace Judas and stated the requirement: someone who accompanied Jesus “all the time He went *in and out* among us.” May we pray like Him, going in and out of heaven!
